

## Guidelines for special day applicants

These guidelines are intended to give general guidance on the objectives of the HoneyRose Foundation. If, on reading the guidelines, you are unsure if the recipient is eligible, please contact the Foundation on 01744 451919.

1. Applications will be accepted from and on behalf of seriously ill adults aged 40 and above, living in the UK. A 'serious illness' is defined as a medical condition which is life-limiting or life-threatening. This has encompassed to date: many different types of cancer, motor neurone disease, muscular dystrophy, multiple sclerosis (later stages), cystic fibrosis, lupus and AIDS.
2. The Foundation will organise and fund a special day for the recipient and their responsible companion, who could be a partner, friend or nurse. If the recipient has children and would like to include them on the day this might also be possible.
3. Special days can be almost anything and are entirely of the applicant's choosing. Some days have made dreams come true – for instance the thrill of a ride in a Ferrari or a hot-air balloon. Others have encouraged total indulgence at a health spa or on the Orient Express, while many have simply brought back a little normality into their lives, such as a family trip to the coast or tickets to the theatre. The Foundation will consider any request however imaginative. For ideas see [Suggestions for a Special Day](#).
4. A member of the medical profession or a social worker must support all applications.
5. The HoneyRose Foundation will endeavour to meet the special day costs for the applicant and their responsible companion plus, where applicable, the applicant's children. Where additional family members and/or friends are included the Foundation may ask for a contribution towards their expenses.
6. **The HoneyRose Foundation is only able to offer special days within the UK.**
